1. Ingredients :

Rock Salt and Proprietary Anti-icing/De-icing Agent

2. Physical Data:

Physical State: Solid

Extinguishing Media: Use media suitable to extinguish source of fire.

4. Health Hazard Data:

Eye: May cause severe irritation. Dust may irritate eyes. If in eyes, hold eyelids open and flush with plenty of clean water for 15 minutes. Get immediate medical attention.

Skin Contact: Short, single exposures are unlikely to cause significant irritation. Likely to cause more severe response if skin is abraded. Prolonged or repeated contact with skin may cause irritation.

Ingestion: Do not take internally. Small amounts swallowed during normal handling operations are unlikely to cause injury. Swallowing amounts larger than that may cause injury.

Inhalation: Vapors are unlikely due to physical properties of the material. Dust may cause irritation to nose and throat.

6. First Aid

Stability: Stable

Incompatibility: None known

Hazardous Decomposition Products: When heated to decomposition (above 1413° C) may emit toxic fumes of Na₂O.

Hazardous Polymerization: Will not occur.

8. Spill or Leak Procedures:

Action To Take For Spills And Leaks: Sweep up and dispose of in accordance with federal, state and local regulations.

Product Disposal: Excess product that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable federal, state and local procedures.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and add rinsate to spray tank. Do not reuse empty container. Offer for recycling or puncture and dispose of according to federal, state and local authorities.

9. Special Protection Information:

Ventilation: Good general ventilation should be sufficient for most conditions.

Respiratory Protection: If vapors, fumes, or dust are present, use MSHA or NIOSH approved respirator, fresh air breathing apparatus, or self-contained breathing apparatus.

Skin Protection: Wear rubber gloves, if desired.

Eye Protection: Use safety goggles.
